We do not believe that 2ml water release is enough after 3 weeks without rain in the summer months the Belubula River is a creek and hardly flowing, we are only a few klms down from the dam so further down must be worse, the water holes drop considerably showing holes in walls of the banks. The wildlife in the river are suffering and 4-5meg perhaps at least should be the minimum release. Also when the water is released it is from the bottom of the dam and very cold which is not good for the fish and water life, can it be released from the top like some dams are doing.
