Submission re: Brigalow and Nandewar Cypress Forest Management

- The State Conservation Areas in the Brigalow and Nandewar forests protect important remnants of western woodland biodiversity/ecosystems/habitat.
- These areas are currently well managed by National Parks and Wildlife Service
- Because these forests contain important habitat for threatened species they have been protected from commercial logging activities and need to remain so.
- Any research into ecological thinning of cypress must be conducted in an independent scientific manner
