Regenerating damaged landscapes. We have had a bush fire in 2019, then an unprecedented flood which isolated us for over a month and badly scoured the riparian zone of our creek. It is now full of devils figs and needs regenerating. Planting trees stops erosion and run off. We have planted and are maintaining a small plot of 50 trees but it will have a minimal impact. This needs to be done on a larger scale.

Offer financial incentives like rate reductions, tax deductions for regenerating and preserving habitat.
