From the information I have researched these forests currently have systems and management plans in place and the NSW Government also has Binding Legal Leases with stake holders such as Grants Holdings Pty Ltd.

I believe that the undue stress the NSW government has placed on the timber industry and the businesses directly feeding of this industry is harmful and has the potential to effect hundreds of people, they are ordinary people that are trying to:

The NATURAL termite resistance that the timber has continues to make this timber a very sort after resource. It is used in many areas that have significant termite activity and is also used in a large amount of renovation projects, particularly in buildings over 25 years old.

It is my understanding that this timber grows particularly well in the drier inland areas of NSW, and therefore it would seem that reducing the use of a natural resource that can and is being sustained in both the current economic and environmental climates would be a very bad business decision.
