ANGAIR is the Anglesea and Aireys Inlet Society for Protection of Flora and Fauna. We have a membership of approx 600 & have been operating for 40 years.

We supported the calls for, and the Victorian Government's creation of new National Parks along the Murray River, through the VEAC River Red Gum investigation process.

We believe that the values of these forests in their natural condition outweigh any exploitative values. We must increase forest cover to sequester CO<sub>2</sub>, we must retain many more trees to grow old & develop hollows for wildlife, we must create biolinks for anticipated movement of species during climate change and we must learn to live within boundaries, not taking from every square metre.

We wish to support calls by The Wilderness Society & others for the New South Wales Government to also create significant new National Parks along the Murray River.
