

Who is the NRC?


Independent advisor to the NSW Govt to improve productivity, conservation and community well being





Recent work

- 1. independent advice on complex issues:
 - active management in conservation areas
 - weeds and pests
 - research priorities
- 2. brokering and mediation on contested issues:
 - who gets the cash?
 - forestry
- 3. accountability and assurance:
 - audits of LLS
 - review of LLS strategic plans, MER
 - Environmental Trust
 - trials on national parks
 - water sharing plans





Independent auditor of LLS

- Independent assurance to investors
 - Enhances the degree of confidence over outputs and outcomes
 - Reduces investment risk
 - Improves organisational effectiveness, performance and accountability
- Objective examination of evidence to assess:
 - Effectiveness of controls and procedures
 - Performance
 - Compliance
- Targeted and focused on a risk basis

Why have a performance standard?

- Benefits for NRM investors
 - confidence that benchmarks are transparently set, and
 - that performance is actively monitored and continuously improved
- Benefits for NRM bodies
 - improved performance, which leads to....
 - better on-ground outcomes
 - increased chance that investor funding is maintained
 - increased likelihood of organisational longevity



Priorities for regional bodies 1. Achieve efficiencies whilst maintaining localism 2. Client service 3. Build trust
